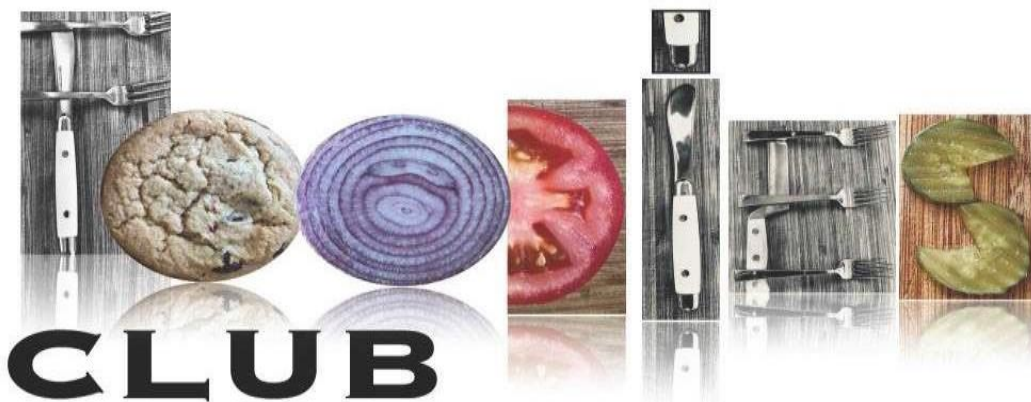

Paula Dean's ***Southern Corn Casserole***

- 1 lg. can corn drained
- 1 lg. can creamed corn
- 8.5 oz. Jiffy corn muffin mix
- 8 oz. sour cream
- ½ lb. butter melted
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- Preheat oven to 350°
- Mix all ingredients except cheese.
- Pour into 9 x 13 greased pan.
- Bake for 45 minutes.
- Top with cheese and bake another 5 minutes or until cheese is melted.
- Let stand for 5 minutes before serving
