October 29, 2020**

Dear Neighbors,

This is Steve Parsons, Annie McCary and Robert Mutchnick. We are residents representing you on the Third Mutual Board of Directors.

We are writing to you because the voting deadline for the Third Mutual ballot proposition is fast approaching. If you have not already voted, we urge you to vote!

Mail has been very slow — and even if you mail your ballot today, there is a chance it might not make it in before the deadline to be counted. The voting deadline is November 2, 2020 at 5 p.m.

Dropping your ballot off in-person at the Community Center ballot box before the deadline will ensure your ballot will be counted. We encourage you to drop off your ballot there, rather than mail it.

As residents of Third Mutual, we share a common interest — doing what is best for Third Mutual and ourselves. Though we may not always agree on the details and the process of how to achieve what is best, we respect the exchange of free and open dialogue to progress us toward our common goal. All voices are welcomed. We assure you that our interest on the Third Mutual Board is to do what we believe is best for all of us. Remember, we live here, too. It would be foolish to want otherwise.

For anyone looking for official information, you can rely upon multiple forms of communication from us, such as Town Halls and a Special Forum that were broadcast live, and also were recorded and are available for viewing on [YouTube](#) and on [Third Mutual's webpage](#).
